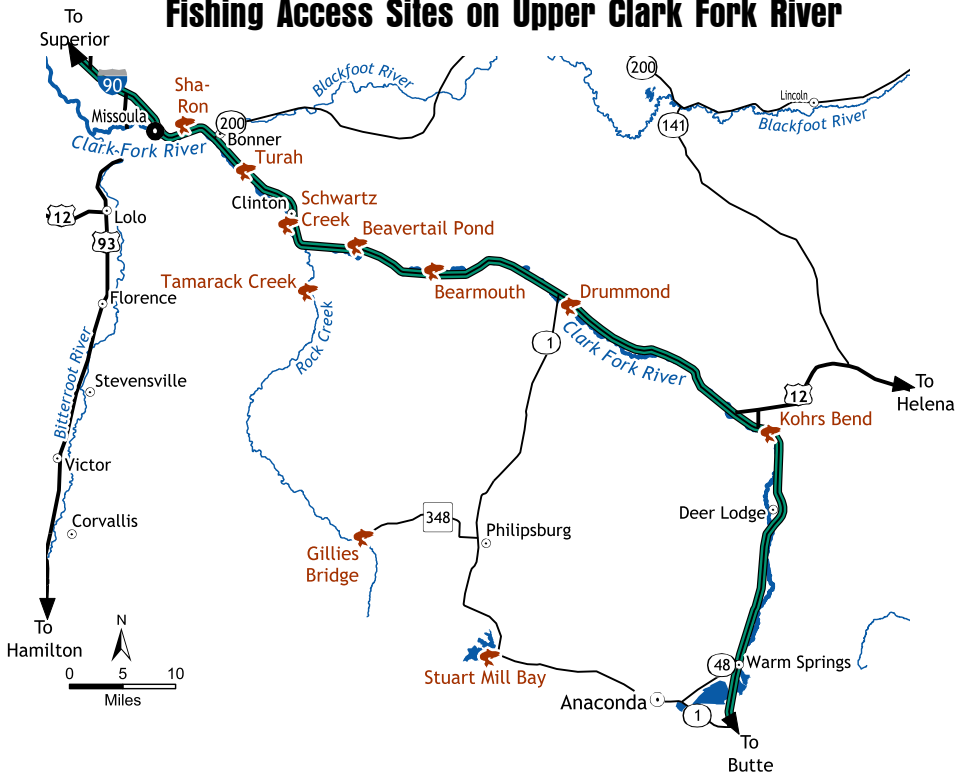


Fishing Access Sites on Upper Clark Fork River



Clark Fork River and Adjacent Areas

Clark Fork River (Upper) (Brook Trout, Brown Trout, Mountain Whitefish, Northern Pike, Rainbow Trout, Smallmouth Bass, Westslope Cutthroat Trout, Yellow Perch)

Kohrs Bend - River Right, Mile 304

Day use only; hand launch only; discharge of weapons prohibited.

Directions: North of Deer Lodge off I-90 at Beck Hill Exit 179, then west on Gravel Road. (R2)

Drummond - River Left, Mile 273

Day use only; concrete boat ramp; discharge of weapons prohibited; site maintained and managed by the city of Drummond. Latrine available at fairgrounds.

Directions: Take Hwy 1 approx. 1 mile towards Phillipsburg and turn left into the Drummond fairgrounds. (R2)

Bearmouth - River Right, Mile 254

Day use only; no boat ramp; discharge of weapons prohibited; primitive, no facilities.

Directions: From Missoula, go east 34 miles on I-90 to the Bearmouth exit, then north for 1/8 of a mile, then turn west on old Frontage Road and travel .5 mile to the FAS. (R2)

Schwartz Creek - River Right, Mile 236

Day use only; gravel/river bottom boat ramp; latrine (ADA accessible); open during established hunting seasons with no weapons restrictions.

Directions: East of Missoula to Clinton Exit 120, south on Frontage Road, then 2 miles east. (R2)

Turah - River Left, Mile 228

Day use only; gravel/river bottom boat ramp; access for trailers; latrine; discharge of weapons prohibited.

Directions: East of Missoula on I-90 to Turah. Exit 113 south, then east for 2 miles. (R2)

Sha-Ron - River Right, Mile 219

Day use only; gravel/river bottom boat ramp; discharge of weapons prohibited.

Directions: Northeast out of east Missoula on old Hwy 10, at bottom of Big Hill, head south on Speedway Road. (R2)

Georgetown Lake (Brook Trout, Kokanee, Rainbow Trout)

Stuart Mill Bay (see Clark Fork River (Upper) map)

13 camp sites - fee charged; gravel/lake bottom boat ramp (shallow water launch site - small craft only); access for trailers (max trailer length 30 ft); latrine; open during established hunting seasons to archery and/or shotgun.

Directions: Travel about 13 miles west of Anaconda on Hwy 1, turn onto Denton's Point Road #672 and go southwest about 1.5 miles. (R2)

Rock Creek (Brook Trout, Brown Trout, Mountain Whitefish, Rainbow Trout, Yellowstone Cutthroat Trout)

Gillies Bridge (see Clark Fork River (Upper) map) - River Right, Mile 43

Day use only; hand launch only; discharge of weapons prohibited; undeveloped.

Directions: 14 miles west of Philipsburg on County Rd 348. (R2)

Tamarack Creek (see Clark Fork River (Upper) map) - River Left, Mile 6

Day use only; hand launch only; open during established hunting seasons with no weapons restrictions.

Directions: Travel 23 miles east of Missoula on I-90, turn onto the Rock Creek Road #102 and go south about 4.5 miles. (R2)
